

HISTORY

Constructed in 1915



Chalmette Refining rests on the historic site of the de la Ronde Plantation. The home burned to the ground in 1876, but the remnants are preserved in the median of West St. Bernard Highway in front of the refinery's main gate. The historic oaks are maintained by the refinery in cooperation with St. Bernard Parish Government.




Chalmette Refining has 500 employees and 200 contractors working onsite.
